

NOTICE

Idyllwild Water District (District) is seeking a qualified firm capable of working in a short period of time to provide design/engineering services for the waterline replacement activities within the District service area in the unincorporated community of Idyllwild (Riverside County).

This project is being financed with both District Capital Improvement Funds and with Community Development Block Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (24 CFR Part 570 and 2 CFR Part 200), and is therefore subject to certain Federal requirements. Information pertaining to the Federal requirements is on file with the County of Riverside Economic Development Agency.

The intent of the District is to hire a firm that has the ability to provide complete design services, plans, specifications, preliminary and final cost estimates, and construction administration for various water distribution system upgrades and improvements.

The project will entail replacement of approximately 3,200 linear feet of aging, deteriorated water line that has been identified as at-risk for failure.
