

ORDINANCE NO. 37
A ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE
IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6
RELATING TO WATER SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. PARAGRAPHS 300, 301 and 302 of ARTICLE 14 of ORDINANCE No.
6 are amended to read as follows:

300. USE OF FIRE HYDRANTS. Fire Hydrants are for use by the Fire Protection Agencies having jurisdiction and by the District. Other parties desiring to use Fire Hydrants for any purpose must first obtain written permission from the District prior to use and shall operate the Fire Hydrant in accordance with the instructions issued by the District. Unauthorized users of Fire Hydrants will be prosecuted pursuant to law.

301. WATER FOR FIRE PROTECTION. A charge to be determined by the District will be levied for water availability, fire hydrant testing and water used for public fire protection. Such charge shall be imposed upon the Fire Protection Agency having primary jurisdiction within the boundaries of the District.

302. MOVING OF FIRE HYDRANTS. When a Fire Hydrant has been installed in the location specified by the Fire Protection Agency having jurisdiction, the further obligation of the Fire Protection Agency having jurisdiction and the District shall cease. If a property owner or other party desires to change in the size, type or location of the Fire Hydrant any change in the location of a Fire Hydrant must be approved by the Fire Protection Agency having jurisdiction.

2. PARAGRAPH ³2. of ARTICLE 18 of ORDINANCE NO. 6 is amended to read as follows:

2. PUBLIC FIRE HYDRANTS. For water availability Fire Hydrant testing and other use for public fire protection, the charge is \$1.25 per Fire Hydrant per month.


3. This ORDINANCE shall take effect in thirty (30)
