

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE IDYLLWILD WATER DISTRICT AMENDING  
SECTION 1.6.03 OF ORDINANCE NO. 23

1 Be it ordained by the Board of Directors of the Idyllwild Water  
2 District as follows:

3 1. Section 1.6.03 of Ordinance No. 23 relating to the use  
4 and construction of sewer facilities is amended to read as  
5 follows:

6 "Within any area of the District where a sewer system has  
7 been provided by the District, the further use of cesspools  
8 or other local means of sewage disposal is hereby declared to be  
9 a public nuisance. Any premises, being a lot or other defined  
10 area of real property improved with a dwelling or other building  
11 used by human beings adjoining any street in which there has been  
12 located a sewer of the District, is hereby required at the ex-  
13 pense of the owner thereof to connect such dwelling or building  
14 to the sewer system of the District after ninety (90) days written  
15 notice by the District to do so and in accordance with the re-  
16 quirements of such notice. Such connection to the District's  
17 sewer system shall only be required where the property is within  
18 one hundred feet (100') of the sewer system.

19 Water service by the District to any premises where the  
20 owner after written notice to connect to the District's sewer  
21 system in compliance with this Section has failed to do so may  
22 be terminated.

23 Written notice of such intended water service termination  
24 shall be given to the owner by registered mail at the address of  
25 such owner shown on the District's records at least forty-five  
26 (45) days before such termination. Such forty-five (45) day  
27 period shall begin on the date of the mailing of the written  
28 notice and end forty-four (44) days thereafter. The owner shall  
29 be entitled upon written demand to a hearing before the General  
30 Manager of the District on the matter of such intended water  
31 service termination. Such hearing shall only be conducted during  
32 the first thirty (30) days of such forty-five (45) day period

1 upon reasonable advance notice to the General Manager and during  
2 the District's regular working hours. Any decision of the  
3 General Manager after such hearing shall be final."

4 2. The Secretary of this District is hereby authorized  
5 and directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published  
6 once in full in a newspaper of general circulation within the  
7 District within ten (10) days after its adoption.
