Be it ordained by the Board of Directors of the IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT as follows:

1 - That there is hereby added to Ordinance No.6, paragraph 256 of Article 12 as follows:

256. Turn Off Charge. A turn off charge of Five Dollars (\$5.00) will be made at the time a request is made by the customer for a discontinuance of service.

2 - That paragraph 251 of Article 11, Ordinance No. 6 be amended as follows:

251. Reconnection Charge. A reconnection charge of Five Dollars (\$5.00) plus penalties or turn off charges will be made and collected prior to renewing service following a disconnection.

3 - That paragraph 174 of Article 9, Ordinance No. 6 be amended as follows:

174. Meter tests - Deposits. All meters will be tested prior to installation and no meter will be installed which registers more than two per cent (2%) fast. If a customer desires to have the meter serving his premises tested, he shall first deposit Five Dollars (\$5.00) for meters up to ¾" in size and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for meters larger than ¾" in size and shall be present when the meter is tested. Should the meter register more than two per cent (2%) fast, the deposit will be refunded but should the meter register less than two per cent (2%) fast, the deposit will be retained by the Water District.

4 - This Ordinance shall be in effect thirty (30) days from the date of adoption.
