State Route 243 Emergency Pavement Operation Idyllwild

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin work on a \$470 thousand emergency project to rehabilitate and repave State Route 243 (SR-243) in Idyllwild within the boundaries of Mount Jacinto State Park.

The project was awarded to SEMA Construction of San Diego, California. Crews will be working on SR-243 from just south of North Circle Drive to just north of Pine Crest Avenue.

Project is scheduled to begin in July

Schedule is dependent on weather and materials availability.

Hours of operation: Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Crews will be paving the roadway and replacing the pavement delineator markers and striping.



Expect one way traffic control with flagging throughout the construction zone. Use caution and follow all instructions from flagging officers for safe passage.

The California Highway Patrol will be on scene to assist with traffic control and safety. Speeds will be reduced by 10 mph in the project parameters.

Watch for signage alerting motorists of upcoming lane closures and construction zone.

The project duration is expected to be three weeks.
